Therefore, we do all we can protect the environment as much as possible. Through prayer, and your agreement & willingness to engage in 220 by rising up to meet the expectations set forth, we know God will move in an amazing way! Let's have a great week - MORE than camp, and know this,... at the end of 220, on Friday - your life will be forever different... stained by His presence and glory-forever! May it be!

## EXPECTATIONS:

As Your 220 staff, know that it is our joy to serve you and your church, as you come to seek the face and heart of God. Please strive to help us protect the spiritual atmosphere of this holy week by following these guidelines listed below:

1. Attend **ALL** scheduled activities. This **INCLUDES 220 Rec.** Even if you are only 'cheering'... **attendance is important!**
2. Respect each other & each other's property at ALL times.
3. Respect 220 staff, crew, leadership, other churches, your church, sponsors, University staff and University property.
4. Dress appropriately for a God centered week. This is at the discretion of your student pastor & church sponsors.
5. Refrain from public displays of affection.
6. Wear your nametag at ALL times. This helps you know the schedule, & indicates you are a part of 220.
7. Remain on campus AT ALL TIMES.
8. Men & Ladies may visit each other's dorm lobbies only - not in halls of dorms and absolutely Not in dorm rooms.
9. Do NOT lose University keys. A lost key will result in a \$45 fee that your church will be charged for.
10. Do NOT move furniture in dorm rooms. SAGU will charge your church if furniture is moved, missing, or damaged.
11. Do not use personal vehicles or 220 staff vehicles or golf carts.
12. Be on time for scheduled events.
13. Please respect your student pastor - when they send you to bed, go to bed. Lights out means lights out.
14. Curfew is 12AM - unless your youth pastor sends you to bed a little later after evening church time - at that point, go straight to your room, lights out, and go to bed to prepare for the next day!
15. Once you are in your room for the evening - No leaving your room until the next morning for breakfast.
16. At 220- you know... BE FLEXIBLE!
17. 220's main rule to remember: DON'T DO STUPID.

\*At 220, we believe by you NOT agreeing and living into these expectations is basically failure to help us protect the Spiritual environment. We believe all of us are held accountable by God for this. Please help us to protect ALL God desires to do by following these guidelines. We always defer to your student pastor when expectations and trust are broken. Ultimately, your Student Pastor and Pastor will decide the consequence of you not helping us to protect the Spiritual environment of 220. If you are sent home by your Pastor/Student Pastor, no refund will be given.
