WHAT TO BRING (AND WHAT NOT TO!)



WHAT TO BRING:

1. Please come to camp with a great attitude and with high expectations for an amazing week!
2. Casual, comfortable, and modest clothing is great! Shorts may be worn in worship services.
3. Clothes for 220 REC (Water may be used so you may get wet, so think through the transparency of white or light-colored clothes).
4. Clothes for Gross Greek Games on Thursday (These clothes could be stained!)
5. Sleeping bag or sheets, blankets, towels, washcloths, soap, toiletries, personal hygiene items
6. Alarm clock and watch
7. Bible, pens, journal, notepad
8. Sunscreen, modest swimsuit
9. Spending money for snacks, T-shirts, CD's, and other resources available
10. Desire and heart to receive all God desires to do
11. Mask and Hand Sanitizer

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

1. Firearms, knives, or weapons of any kind
2. Fireworks or pranking supplies
3. Alcohol, tobacco or vaping products, drugs of any kind
4. Skateboards, laser pointers, iPods, hand held gaming systems, etc. - anything that can be a distraction
5. PLEASE limit cell phone usage to only a few minutes of the day and only at certain break times! Please note: cell phone usage is at the discretion of your student pastor. Some may ask students not to bring cell phones to camp. Please check with your student pastor.

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Student Expectations



Dear Student,

For years now, God has moved in such powerful and supernatural ways through the ministry of 220. Literally thousands of people's lives have been forever changed because of what God has done. This year will be no different. The presence of Jesus will change many of the lives of your friends and possibly even your own. In order to ensure we cultivate the most conducive atmosphere in which God can move, we have some expectations that we hold in high regard.

EXPECTATIONS:

1. Attend and be on time to all scheduled activities, **INCLUDING 220 REC.** Even if you are only "cheering," **attendance is important.**
2. Respect each other and each other's property at all times.
3. Respect 220 staff, crew, leadership, other churches, your church, sponsor, university staff and university property.
4. Dress appropriately for a God-centered week. Your Student Pastor and Church sponsors will help you determine what is appropriate if you have questions.
5. Refrain from public and private displays of affection. It's not the time nor the place.
6. Wear your nametag at ALL times. This is a requirement of the university.
7. Remain on campus AT ALL TIMES.
8. Men and Women may visit each other's dorm lobbies only, not in halls or rooms.
9. Hang on to your dorm key. A lost key will result in a \$45 fee charged to your church.
10. Do NOT move furniture in your dorm room or the university will charge your church.
11. Do not use personal vehicles or 220 staff vehicles or golf carts.
12. Lights out mean lights out. Please respect your student pastor and sponsors.
13. Curfew is 12AM (Midnight), unless your church time runs a little long. At that point, go straight to your room, lights out, and go to sleep. You want to be ready and rested the next day.
14. Once you are in your room for the night, do not leave until the next morning for breakfast.
15. Respect the Covid-19 threat and others – please adhere to social distancing and wearing of your mask, where appropriate
16. BE FLEXIBLE!
17. And our main 220 rule, **DON'T DO STUPID!**
